


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ARE INTERNATIONAL PULP PRICES STABILIZING IN MID-2018?

ata sources on the US dollar price per ton of pulp indicate distinct trends in the dollar quotation for Northern Bleached Softwood Kraft Pulp (NBSKP) in mid-2018. Natural Resources Canada (see Graph 1 and Table 1) indicates that, after 16 highs, international prices in US dollars for NBSKP in May were the same as those in effect in April in the United States, as well as in Europe and China.



However, Euwid's graphs (www.euwid-paper.com) indicate highs in the US dollar price for NBSKP in both Europe and the United States in June versus May, and in May versus April.

Data from the Royal Bank of Canada (see Table 2) indicates slight increases in the price per ton of NBKSP in the United States in May compared to April quotations.

Notwithstanding the uncertainty of what's happening with US dollar quotations per ton of NBKSP in international markets (still room to increase or are prices stabilizing?), US dollar quotations of Bleached Hardwood Kraft Pulp (BHKP) are stable in mid-2018. Table 3 shows that the price quotation for a ton of Bleached Hardwood Kraft Pulp (BHKP) in Brazil in July 2018 is practically the same as in June, both in terms of price without discount (the so-called list price), as well as for the average size client. And Euwid's graphs for the price in US dollar per ton of BHKP coming from South America indicate stability in the same period.

Euro quotations for kraftliner and A4 papers in Europe in June 2018 were the same as in May.

In the São Paulo market, brown papers saw a slight increase in average prices in Brazilian reais (R\$), but with no immediate impact on the recycled paper market.

INTERNATIONAL MARKETS

Europe

Data from Natural Resources Canada (Graph 1 and Table 1) indicates stability in US dollar quotations per ton of Northern Bleached Softwood Kraft Pulp (NBSKP) in Europe in May, with an average value of US\$ 1,170. Compared to December 2016, this product increased US\$ 360 per ton, a relative high of 44.4%.

Euwid's graphs indicate stability in Euro quotations for kraftliner and A4 paper sold in Europe in June versus May 2018.

USA

Distinct sources based on different samples usually present values that are not equal for the same variable. However, it's expected that the trends in these sources for the same variable be identical. This does not occur with US dollar prices per ton of NBSKP in the United States according to data from Natural Resources Canada (NRC) and Royal Bank of Canada (RBC).

Comparing the values in Tables 1 and 2, we see that RBC reports a price of US\$ 1,270 in May for a ton of NBSKP in the United States, which value NRC indicated was valid in March 2018 for the North American market. For NRC, the price in US dollar for the ton of NBSKP in the United States is the same in May and June. However, according to RBC, prices increased.

This differing information between NRC and RBC raises doubts whether the US dollar price per ton of NBSKP in the United States is tending to stabilize, or not, in mid-2018.

RBC data indicates a persistent high in the US dollar price for newsprint in the USA (see Table 2). From January to May 2018, the US dollar price per ton of this product increased US\$ 53.90, that is, 9.7% in relation to its price in December 2017 (when it was US\$ 558 per ton).

China

Graph 1 already indicates China's pressure to stabilize the US dollar quotation on the ton of NBSKP since the beginning of 2018. As a result, major differences occur in the dollar quote per ton of NBSKP between the US, European and Chinese markets. In May 2018, the dollar price per ton of NBKSP sold in China was 70.4% of the price charged in the United States and 78.2% of the price in Europe, according to NRC (see Table 1).

BRAZILIAN MARKET

Pulp market

The data in Table 3 indicates stability in the US dollar quotation of hardwood pulp in Brazil in July vis-à-vis June 2018.

Paper market

Prices in Brazilian reais (R\$) for cut size and board in big industry sales to big buyers did not change in June compared to May, and prices are not expected to change in July (see Tables 4 and 5). However, there was a slight increase in the price of offset paper at this negotiation level.

This increase in offset paper prices also occurs in sales by dealers to small print shops and copiers in the Campinas (SP) region, as shown in Table 7.

As of this month, this column will no longer publish minimum prices for brown line packaging papers in Brazil, which are characterized as internal transfer prices between companies. With the removal of these prices, average prices for fluting, testliner and kraftliner papers were revised.

Table 6 presents revised data for the average price of fluting, testliner and kraftliner papers since January 2018 plus the average price per ton of sack kraft. An increase of 1.4%, 2.2% and 1.7% was observed in the average price for fluting, testliner and kraftliner papers in June versus May 2018. Preliminary data, but not divulged in this edition, indicates new highs in fluting and kraftliner prices in July.

Recycled paper

The recycled paper market ended up being significantly affected by the truckers' strike in May, which led to the formation of big inventories at recyclers and the need to move this product in June. As a result, practically all recycled paper quotations in Brazilian reais (R\$) in June were identical as May, except for a slight increase in the average price of recycled folding board type 1 (see Table 9).

With the recent increases in fluting and kraftliner prices and the fact that imported recycled material (see Table 10) in June being registered at higher prices in US dollars, there's a possibility that recycled paper prices will increase in July. This data will be reported in the next edition of this magazine.
