

# INTERNATIONAL AGENCIES DIFFER ON DOLLAR PRICE TRENDS FOR SOFTWOOD KRAFT PULP

he three international sources for dollar prices of Northern Bleached Softwood Kraft Pulp (NBSKP) which this analysis is based on – Natural Resources Canada, Royal Bank of Canada-Bloomberg and Euwid – present different trends for the dollar quote per ton of this product at the beginning of the second semester of 2018.

Natural Resources Canada (NRC) reports a price increase in dollar per ton of NBSKP in the United States and Europe in July compared to its price quotes in June (see Graph 1).



However, the Royal Bank of Canada (RBC) in partnership with Bloomberg reported a price drop in dollar per ton of NBSKP in the United States for July vis-à-vis June (see Table 2). While Euwid (www.euwid-paper.com), in its graphs, indicates stability in dollar prices for this product in Europe and United States in July and August compared to June prices.

Prices in euros for offset paper and kraftliner in August were the same as those in July in Europe.

In domestic sales of BHKP, the price list in dollar for this product remained constant in the third quarter (US\$ 1,050 per ton). However, medium-size clients have been obtaining minimal price reductions in dollar for this product.

Prices in Brazilian reais (R\$) for paper sold by the industry to big consumers and dealers in Brazil in September (when compared to August prices) show variations in both directions (price increases, reductions or constant values).

As mentioned in this column last month, significant price increases

occurred in August for white and brown recycled material in the state of São Paulo compared to their July prices. And new price increases in Brazilian reais (R\$) for these recycled materials are expected in September. ## **INTERNATIONAL MARKETS**

#### Europe

The dollar price in July per ton of NBSKP in Europe was US\$ 1,230, registering a small increase of US\$ 5 in relation to its price in June (see Table 1).

# USA

In the US, according to Natural Resources Canada, the price per ton of NBSKP in July was US\$ 1,375, an increase of US\$ 25 per ton in relation to June prices (see Table 1). But the Royal Bank of Canada (in partnership with Bloomberg), see Table 2, reports an NBSKP ton price in July of US\$ 1,286 in the US, dropping US\$ 28.40 in relation to the price in June.

This is the first time in the last two years that the two sources (NRC and RBC) report distinct trends in the dollar price of NBSKP.

As already reported in its graphs, Euwid shows stability in the dollar price per ton of NBSKP in July and August in the United States and Europe compared to their quotes in June.

This non-coincidence in dollar prices per ton of NBSKP clearly indicates an interruption in rising prices that was occurring since January 2017.

## China

NRC data (see Table 1) clearly indicates that the dollar price per ton of NBSKP in China has begun to drop as of the start of the second semester of 2018. In July, the ton of NBSKP was sold for US\$ 910 in China, compared to US\$ 915 in June.

# **BRAZILIAN MARKET**

# **Pulp market**

The data presented in Table 3 shows stability in the dollar price list per ton of Bleached Hardwood Kraft Pulp (BHKP) sold in the domestic market (US\$ 1,050 per ton). However, the average price paid by medium-size customers for this product

is experiencing a slight drop in the third quarter of 2018. The price went from US\$ 932.58 in July to US\$ 930.90 in September (0.18% reduction).

### Paper market

In looking at Tables 4 and 5, we see price drops in reais (R\$) for duplex board (ream and reel) in sales from industry to big consumers or dealers in September compared to August prices. But the price of offset paper in reais (R\$) at this level of negotiation increased during this time. This price increase in offset paper is also observed in dealer sales to small print shops and copiers, as shown in Table 7, which represents the offset and coated paper market in the Campinas region in sales made to such clients.

In terms of brown line packaging papers, selling prices to big consumers in September (vis-à-vis August) experienced a slight increase of 0.6% in the average price of testliner paper and a slight reduction in the average price of fluting paper (see Table 6).

## **Recycled** paper

We see in Table 9 that the average price of recycled material (white, brown, newsprint) increased in August in comparison to July. White recycled material prices, types 1, 2 and 4, increased 3.2%, 1.4% and 1.0%, respectively. In turn, the average price increase for brown recycled material, types 1 and 2, for the same period was 0.6% and 0.8%, respectively. Recycled newsprint prices increased 1.1%. The average price for type 3 brown recycled material and folding board remained the same.
